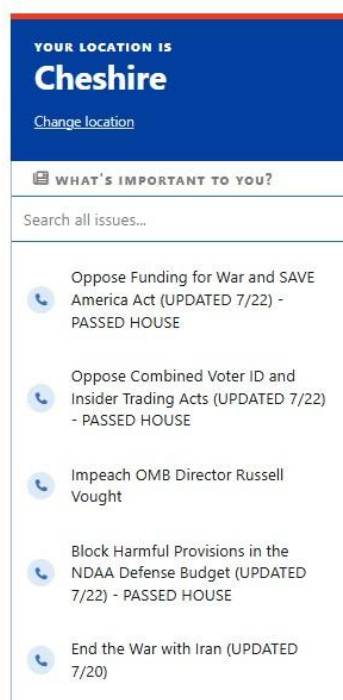

### **Activate America** <https://www.activateamerica.vote/postcards>

Founded in 2017, Activate America focuses on reaching voters in key districts to flip seats from red-to-blue and hold onto some of the most vulnerable US House and Senate seats. **National House and Senate races and Get-out-the-Vote campaigns.** Addresses and script are provided. Postcards and stamps are not provided. Generally, a 3-4 week mailing window.

### **Postcards to Swing States** <https://turnoutpac.org/postcards/>

The Progressive Turnout Project is the largest voter contact organization in the country specifically dedicated to mobilizing the Democratic Party. Their mission is to rally Democrats to vote – targeting presidential swing states to competitive state legislative districts. **Strictly get-out-the-vote messaging.** Postcards, addresses and script are provided. Stamps are not provided. Generally, a 3-4 week mailing window.

### **Postcards to Voters / Tony the Democrat** <https://postcardstovoters.org/postcards/>

National key races are targeted. Postcard writers must prepare a sample postcard for review to become an authorized volunteer (easy process). You can request as few as 5 addresses at a time. Addresses and script are provided. Postcards and stamps are not provided. Generally, a 3-4 day mailing window.
